

Northern Transportation (NTCL) Careers and Leadership Bursary*

The NTCL bursary has been initiated to encourage youth to stay in school and is dedicated to developing NTCL's future workforce through higher education.

NTCL is a member of the NorTerra Group of Companies. NorTerra is a 100% aboriginal-owned management holding company, owned equally by the Inuvialuit Development Corporation, representing the Inuvialuit of the Western Arctic and Nunasi Corporation, representing the Inuit of Nunavut. NTCL is Canada's only pan-Arctic marine operator, providing cost-effective, reliable and comprehensive marine transportation and related services throughout Northern Canada and the Arctic.

Who is eligible?

- Inuit beneficiaries of the Nunavut Land Claim Agreement and Inuvialuit beneficiaries of the Inuvialuit Final Agreement
- Youth aged between 13 – 18 years, enrolled and actively attending full-time studies between Grades 9 –12.

What awards are available?

- Bursaries of \$250 each will be awarded to eligible applicants as determined by the selection committee.

How are the award recipients selected?

- By a selection committee comprised of NTCL & NorTerra employees and a member of the Board of Directors.

What can I use the award for?

- The NTCL award may be used for books, computers and other educational equipment, transportation, housing, food or clothing.

When will I know if I've been selected?

All applicants and award winners will be notified in mid-September by mail. No results will be given over the phone. Names of recipients will be posted by December 1 on NTCL's web-site: www.ntcl.com.

Applications must be received at NTCL's office no later than June 15 of each year.

Include any awards you have received, community and volunteer work you have done, special school activities you participate in and what have you done to preserve your culture or heritage.
- **LETTER** of recommendation or support from a community member.
- **LETTER** of recommendation from a teacher or school counselor.
- **COPY** of your most recent high school report card.
